

The call to Serve as a Spírítual Leader...

- no time for self-care and spiritual renewal
- no safe person to talk with about all this, other than your spouse

Here at the Journey Center, we know from many years of experience what it is like to serve as a spiritual leader (both "the agony and the ecstasy"!). God has called us to develop and offer resources for you and your faith communityresources that will help you to:

-tend to the needs of those in your care, AND-tend to your own health and spiritual well-being.



Resources for Pastors, Clergy and Spouses

We offer vital resources designed for those who are engaged in the challenge of leading faith communities.
